## 5. Resolutions on the decolonisation of the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic

The Pan-African Parliament,

**CONCERNED** by the issue of decolonisation in the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic;

**RECALLING** that the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic is a full Member of the African Union and the Pan-African Parliament;

**ENCOURAGING** the Saharawi people to continue their quest for decolonisation and self-determination;

**EXPRESSING** its solidarity to the Saharawi people for their just struggle;

**SUPPORTING** the right of the people of Saharawi to a referendum to determine their future;

## THEREFORE RESOLVES:

- 1. To strengthen advocacy on the plight of the people of Western Sahara by ensuring that the issue takes prominence on the agenda of all African Union Summits;
- 2. To remain committed to the issue of Western Sahara until the long and much awaited referendum is organised in an environment which is fair, free and transparent by the UN.
