ORDINANCE, 1970: PROMULGATION OF

The Administrator has been pleased to assent, in terms of section 27 of the South West Africa Constitution Act, 1968 (Act 39 of 1968) to the following Ordinance which is hereby published for general information in terms of section 29 of the said Act:—

ORDINANCE

To amend the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 11 of 1963) to provide for the re-establishment and re-constitution of the Townships Board, and the term of office of its members; to prescribe a penalty for continuous offences; to empower the making of regulations with respect to the vacation of their office by certain members of the Board, the filling of casual vacancies and meetings of the Board; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

(Assented to 23rd March 1970)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of South West Africa as follows:—

1. (1) The following section is hereby substituted for section 2 of the Townships and Division of Land Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 11 of 1963) hereinafter called the principal Ordinance:—

Amendment of section 2 of Ordinance 11 of 1963.

“Establishment and constitution of the Townships Board.

2. (1) There is hereby established a Board to be known as the Townships Board consisting of not less than five and not more than ten members.

(2) The Surveyor-general, the Registrar of Deeds, the Chief Roads Engineer, the Director of Works and the Head, Local Government Branch of the Administration, or any officer of his office nominated in his stead by the said Surveyor-General, Registrar of Deeds, Chief Roads Engineer, Director of Works or Head, Local Government Branch, as the case may be, for the purpose of any meeting, shall be members of the Board *ex officio*. The Administrator shall appoint a person as member of the Board who shall bring to the notice of the Board the views of local authorities and the interests of the inhabitants of local authority areas, and shall also appoint the other members of the Board.

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(3) The Administrator shall designate one of the members of the Board as chairman. In the absence of the chairman the members present shall elect from amongst themselves a chairman for the purpose of that meeting.

(4) Subject to any regulation providing for the vacation of office by a member, each member of the Board, other than persons who are members *ex officio*, shall hold office for such period, not exceeding three years, as the Administrator may determine, but shall be eligible for re-appointment for such further period, not exceeding three years, as the Administrator may determine.

(5) The Administrator may nominate any person as the deputy of any member of the Board, other than an *ex-officio* member, to act for such member whenever he is prevented by illness, absence or any other cause from performing the duties of his office: Provided that the appointment of any such deputy member shall be held subject to the regulations referred to in subsection (4).

(6) Any member of the Board who is not an officer of the public service or an officer in the service of the Administration may be paid from the Territory Revenue Fund such remuneration, allowances and fees as the Administrator may from time to time determine.

(7) Upon the commencement of this section the existing Board shall be dissolved and the members thereof shall vacate office.”.

(2) Subsection (1) shall come into operation upon a date to be determined by the Administrator by proclamation in the *Official Gazette*.

2. Section 31 (2) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after the words “six months” of the following words:—

Amendment of section 31 of Ordinance 11 of 1963 as amended by section 10 of Ordinance 36 of 1967.

“, and in the case of a continuous offence to an additional fine not exceeding four rand for each day on which the offence continues”.

3. Section 36 (1) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:—

Amendment of section 36 of Ordinance 11 of 1963 as amended by section 12 of Ordinance 36 of 1967.

(a) by the substitution for the word “prescribing” of the words “with respect to”;

(b) by the substitution for paragraphs (a) and (b) of the following paragraphs:—

“(a) the circumstances under which a member of the Board, other than a person who is a member *ex officio*, shall vacate his office, and the filling of casual vacancies;

(aA) the meetings of the Board, the conduct of proceedings thereat and the number of members who shall constitute a quorum for any meeting;

(b) the form of any application in terms of this Ordinance and the information and documents to be submitted with such application;”.

4. This ordinance shall be called the Townships and Division of Land Amendment Ordinance, 1970. Short title.
