AN ACT to amend the Judiciary Act, 2008 (Act 9 of 2008).

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Judiciary (Amendment) Act, 2014 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st July, 2014.

2. The Judiciary Act, 2008 is hereby amended as follows—

(a) in section 5 by inserting after paragraph (d), the following paragraph—


“(e) upon completion of every five years of service, or part thereof, in the case of vacation otherwise than by being removed under Article 134 of the Constitution, to the President of the Court of Appeal or a Justice of Appeal, a gratuity of an amount equal to 50% of salary earned during that period.”;

(b) in section 11(1) by repealing paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the following paragraphs—

“(a) a monthly salary of a sum specified at step 1 of salary band-16 of the Public Service Salary Table under the Public Service Salary Act, 2013, which shall on completion of each 12 month be progressed to the next step in accordance with that salary band;

(aa) a transport allowance of R.5,600 per month;”.
