ANACT to amend the Civil Status Act (Cap.34)

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Civil Status (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Short title

 Amendment of Cap 34 2. (1B) The fee prescribed under subsection (1A) shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund and the officer shall be entitled to receive an allowance, per marriage celebrated, as may be prescribed. (c) the allowances payable to an officer who celebrates a marriage ----
