AN ACT to amend the Children Act (Cap 28)

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

1. This Act may be cited as the Children (Amendment) Act, 2017. Short title

2. The Children Act is hereby amended as follows—
- (a) in section 77—
- (i) in subsection (1) by repealing the words “five other members” and substituting therefor the words “not less than five and not more than thirteen members”;
- (ii) in subsection (3) by repealing the word “Vice-Chairperson” and substituting therefor the word “Vice-Chairpersons” and by repealing the word “years” and substituting therefor the word “years’”;
- (b) by repealing in section 78(8) the words “The Chief Justice” and substituting therefor the words “The Minister, in consultation with the Chief Justice,”.
