Food (Import Certificate) Regulations, 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 38 read with section 5(c), and (e) of the Food Act, the Minister responsible for Family Affairs acting as the Minister responsible for Health makes the following Regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Food (Import Certificate) Regulations, 2019.
2. An importer wishing to import a food item listed in column 1 of the table under Schedule 1 shall furnish a certificate specified in column 2 of the table.
