## SEYCHELLLES HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION ACT, 2018

(Act 7 of 2018)

# Seychelles Human Rights Commission (Salary and Allowances of Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and Commissioners) Regulations, 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 27 read with section 10(1) of Seychelles Human Rights Commission Act, 2018, the President being the Minister responsible for Legal Affairs makes the following regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Seychelles <sub>Citation</sub> Human Rights Commission (Salary and Allowances of Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and Commissioners) Regulations, 2019.

**2.**(1) (a) Subject to paragraph (b), the monthly salary of the Chairperson shall be the sum specified at Step 13 of Salary Band 14 of the Public Salary Table under the Public Service Salary Act, 2013 (Act 25 of 2013).

(b) Where the Chairperson is a retired Judge or Justice of Appeal, the salary of the Chairperson shall be  ${}^{5}_{7}$  of the exit salary of the Judge or Justice of Appeal.

(2) Where the total certified number of hours of work or meetings of the commission exceed 25 hours in any given month, the Chairperson shall be paid an allowance calculated at the rate of SCR361.00 for each hour worked in excess of the 25 hours.

**3.**(1) The monthly salary of the Deputy Chairperson shall be the sum specified at Step 4 of Salary Band 11 of the

Salary of Deputy Chairperson Public Salary Table under the Public Service Salary Act, 2013 (Act 25 of 2013).

(2) Where the total certified number of hours of work of the Deputy Chairperson exceed 25 hours in any given month, the Deputy Chairperson shall be paid an allowance calculated at the rate of SCR217.00 for each hour worked in excess of the 25 hours.

Salary of Commissioners **4.**(1) The monthly salary of a Commissioners shall be the sum specified at Step 11 of Salary Band 7 of the Public Salary Table under the Public Service Salary Act, 2013 (Act 25 of 2013).

> (2) Where the total certified number of hours of work the Commissioner exceed 25 hours in any given month, the Commissioner shall be paid an allowance calculated at the rate of SCR130.00 for each hour worked in excess of the 25 hours.

Other terms and conditions **5.** The terms and conditions specified in the Public Service Order shall be applicable to the Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and Commissioners, subject to these Regulations.
