The Appropriation Act, 2024

Short title.

Being an Act to Authorise expenditure from the Consolidated Fund for the services of Sierra Leone for the year 2024 and for other related matters.

Date of commencement.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of sums of money necessary to meet the expenditure to carry on the services of the Government:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is enacted by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled as follows:- i movenoument

 This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 2024.

NLe 21,462,767,800 granted for 2024. 2. The sum of twenty one billion four hundred and sixty two million seven hundred and sixty seven thousand eight hundred Leones shall be and is hereby granted to His Excellency the President for and during the year two thousand and twenty four to be applied and expended in the manner herein described and for the several services set forth in the Schedule.

NLe 21,462,767,800 charged on revenue. 3. The sum of twenty one billion four hundred and sixty two million seven hundred and sixty seven thousand eight hundred Leones referred to in section 2, shall be and is hereby declared to be charged upon and made payable from and out of the Consolidated Fund for the year two thousand and twenty four and the payment thereof shall be taken to begin on and immediately after the first day of January, two thousand and twenty four.

Accountant General's authority for payment. 4. The Accountant-General is hereby authorised and required to pay out of the Consolidated Fund for the several services specified in the Schedule, such sums as may be specified in the Warrant or Order of the Minister of Finance, issued from time to time up to the sum of twenty one billion four hundred and sixty two million seven hundred and sixty seven thousand eight hundred Leones which shall come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, two thousand and twenty four.

Excess of Expenditure.

5. The amount form time to time paid for and in respect of the expenditure authorized in Section 4 shall not exceed in the gross the sum of twenty one billion four hundred and sixty two million seven hundred and sixty seven thousand eight hundred Leones from the first day of January, two thousand and twenty four inclusive, and any balances remaining unissued at the end of December, two thousand and twenty four shall lapse and not be available for making any payment in the following year.
