#### THE NATIONAL PARKS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2018

Citation G.N.No 255 of 1970

1. These Regulations may be cited as The National Parks (Amendment) Regulations, 2018 and shall be read as one with the National Parks Regulations, 1970 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations.

Fees

2. The fees payable in respect of the Schedule specified in the First Schedule to these Regulations shall come into force on the 20<sup>th</sup> October 2018 except for Gombe National park's kasekela luxury camp fees which shall come into force on the date of gazettement of these tariffs and tariffs under items " J(iii), (vi), Q(b), S(b), S (c) W and Z" shall come into force from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019.

Revocation of the schedule to G.N. No. 255 of 1970 3. The Schedule to the National Parks Regulations is hereby deleted and substituted for it the following:

# CONDITIONS FORMING PART OF THESE REGULATIONS (TARIFFS);

### The following conditions shall form part of these Regulations;

- (i) There shall be no deductions of whatever kind such as taxes, levies, commissions and service charges during computation and payment of concession fee
- (ii) The tariffs shall be reviewed after a period of three (3) years
- (iii) All written fees are for single entry.

- (iv) For a single entry, permit is valid for 24 hours except when climbing Mt. Kilimanjaro and Mt. Meru, where permit is valid for daylight hours.
- (v) Holders of Directors' Pass and other pass must alide to specific guide lines.

- (vi) Proof of identification is mandatory at entry gate.
- (vii) Fee once paid is non refundable
- (viii) Expatriates / residents and their dependants living in Tanzania must have either of the following documents; resident permits Class A, B, C, exemption certificate, temporary pass attached with government receipt or acknowledgement letter, diplomatic passport or Diplomatic or National Identity card.
- (ix) EAC Citizens refers to nationals of Tanzania, Kenya, Uganda, Burundi, Rwanda & South Sudan.
- (x) Nationals of other EAC member states must produce their passport at entry gate
- (xi) EAC private vehicles are strictly prohibited to conduct any tourism business in the park.
- (xii) Snorkers should have their own equipments.
- (xiii) Students here is defined as a natural person studying (on full time bases) in a registered primary/ secondary/high school/ college/ university EAC education institution.
- (xiv) Video shooting: This is where a group of persons enters the park for the purpose of recording their own work/ art/ song/ any creation of their intellectual right. Fees per group for video shooting is paid on top of daily conservation fee. Group here means 2 to 20 persons.
- (xv) All Tariffs are VAT exclusive. VAT is 18%
- (xvi) Payments are made using government electronic payment gate way (GEPG-MOF) online, bank and mobile
