THE URBAN PLANNING (MLOKA PLANNING AREA)(DECLARATION) ORDER, 2019

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Urban Planning (Mloka Planning Area)(Declaration) Order, 2019 and shall come into operation on the date of publication.

Declaration of planning area Cap.355 2. The area prescribed in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a planning area for the purposes of the Urban Planning Act.

Scheme of scheduled area

3. General and detailed schemes for the scheduled area shall be prepared and deposited with the Director of Urban and Rural Planning and Rufiji District Executive Director.

## SCHEDULE

## (Made under paragraph 2)

Description of Boundaries of Mloka Planning Area

The boundary commences at the survey beacon number NP3 then 8880.17 meters in South West  $(176^{0}09' \ 30'')$  it then extends to survey point 3  $(44^{0}43' \ 40'')$  in 4818.58 meters it then continues along the same direction to the survey point 2  $(217^{0} \ 52'30'')$  in 9859.01 meters. Again the boundary continues along the same direction through  $(232^{0} \ 24' \ 26'')$  in North West direction to the survey point VP852 which also acts as a **boundary between a Village and Selous**

Game Reserve area. Then the boundary goes to survey point VP 853 in South West direction  $(187^0 29' 40'')$  in 3304.23 meters and then furthest in the South West direction  $(224^0 08' 30'')$  to survey beacon VP 375 then it goes further to the West direction  $(400^0 00'00'')$  to survey beacon VP 847 and lastly the boundary goes to the West direction  $(201^0 04'00'')$  in 4818.58 meters.

The geographical description of MLOKA PLANNING AREA is prescribed in accordance with Mloka Village boundary. The area prescribed in Town Planning drawing No.19/RUF/138/102018-MLOKA PLANNING AREA.
