Citation GN No. 368 of 2009

1. These Rules may be cited as the Tanzania Court of Appeal (Amendments) Rules, 2022 and shall be read as one with the Tanzania Court of Appeal Rules, hereinafter referred to as the "principal Rules."

Amendment of rule 26

2. The principal Rules are amended by deleting rule 26 and substituting for it the following:

"Court business during vacations 26.-(1) The vacations of the Court shall be from 15th December to 31st January and from the second Saturday before Easter to the first Tuesday after, inclusive.

- (2) No court business shall be conducted during vacations, unless the Chief Justice direct otherwise, except the delivery of judgment and when the matter is shown to be of urgency, the hearing of application and the taxation of bills.
- (3) A certificate of urgency shall not be granted unless justified by the special circumstances of the case or serious hardship."

Amendment of rule 30

3. The principal Rules are amended in rule 30 by adding immediately after sub rule (6), the following:

GN. No. 637 of 2021 "(7) Notwithstanding the preceding provisions of this rule, the Court may direct the proceedings before it to be conducted remotely in accordance with the provisions of
