Definitions

1. In this notice "the regulations" shall mean the Regulations Regarding Fees and Fines Payable to The South African Nursing Council published by Government Notice No. R170 of 8 March 2013;
2. In this notice "Board Notice" shall mean [Board Notice 80 of 2019](#) published under the Regulations.

Restoration fees

To include into the Board Notice before paragraph 8, a paragraph 7 (A) that holds:

7(A) "Despite any notice to the contrary, any Nurse Practitioner who wishes to restore to the register for the sole purpose of rendering health services during the COVID-19 National State of Disaster in the:

- I. Prevention of COVID-19, and or;
- II. Prevention of the spread of COVID-19, and or;
- III. Treatment of patients affected by COVID-19,

for the period of the declared National State Disaster shall pay a restoration fee of R0.00."
