**ACT**

No. 2 of 1981

Date of Assent: 4th March, 1981

**An Act to repeal and replace the Presidential Emoluments Act; to provide for the revised salary, allowance and gratuity payable to the holder of the office of President; and to provide for matters connected with or incidental to the foregoing.**

[6th March, 1981

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Presidential Emoluments Act, 1981.

Short title and commencement

(2) Section *two* shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st August, 1980, and the other provisions of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st December, 1980.

2. The President shall be paid—

Salary and allowance

(a) a salary calculated at the annual rate of K16,700;

(b) an allowance calculated at the annual rate of K13,300.

3. A person who has held the office of President for at least three years shall, upon the expiration of his term of office or upon his ceasing to be President, be paid a gratuity equal to twenty-five per centum of the aggregate amount of emoluments paid or payable to him in respect of the period spent in office.

Gratuity

4. The Presidential Emoluments Act, 1977, is hereby repealed.
