No. 10 of 1983

Date of Assent: 8th April, 1983

An Act to confirm the supplementary expenditure of moneys aggregating one hundred and ten million, five hundred and sixty-eight thousand and forty-one kwacha, required for the services of the Republic during the financial year ended on the 31st December, 1981.

#### ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1981) Act, 1983.

The expenditure on the services of the Republic during the financial year ended on the 31st December, 1981, of the moneys indicated in respect of those services in the third column of the Schedule, being expenditure in excess of the moneys appropriated for the services by the Appropriation Act, 1981, is hereby confirmed.
