ACT

No. 12 of 1985

Date of Assent: 2nd April, 1985

An Act to provide for the vesting of the undertaking of the Cold Storage Board of Zambia in Zambia Cold Storage Corporation Limited; to provide for the winding-up and dissolution of the Cold Storage Board of Zambia; to repeal the Cold Storage Board of Zambia Act; and to provide for matters connected with or incidental to the foregoing.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Ensotment

1. This Act may be cited as the Cold Storage Board of Zambia (Dissolution) Act, 1985, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by statutory instrument, appoint.

Short title and commencement

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation

"appointed date" means such date as the Minister shall appoint in pursuance of the provisions of section three;

Cap. 686

"Company" means Zambia Cold Storage Corporation Limited, a company registered under the Companies Act;

Cap. 390

"Board" means the Cold Storage Board of Zambia established by section three of the Cold Storage Board of Zambia Act.

Winding-up of affairs of Board and its dissolution

3. (1) From the commencement of this Act the Board shall exist only for the purpose of winding-up its affairs, and for no other purpose.

(2) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Cold Storage Board of Zambia Act, or in any other written law, the Board shall have, for the purpose of winding up its affairs, power to do anything which is necessary or expedient for that purpose or which is incidental thereto, including

in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of that power, power to enter into and carry out agreements and arrangements for the transfer of its property, rights, liabilities and obligations to any person or the Government.

(3) When the Minister is satisfied that all necessary agreements and arrangements have been made for the winding-up of the affairs of the Board so that it may be dissolved, he shall, by statutory instrument, order that the Board shall be dissolved on such date as may be appointed in the statutory instrument.

Vesting in Company of assets and liabilities of Board

- 4. (1) On the appointed date there shall be trasferred to, and vest in, the Company by virtue of this Act and without further assurance—
 - (a) the undertaking of the Board; and
 - (b) subject to the provisions of this Act, all property, rights, liabilities and obligations which immediately before the appointed date were property, rights, liabilities and obligations of the Board.
- (2) Subject to the approval of the Company and as hereinafter provided, every deed, bond and agreement (other than an agreement for personal service) to which the Board was a party immediately before the commencement of this Act, whether in writing or not, and whether or not of such a nature that rights, liabilities and obligations thereunder could be assigned, shall, unless its subject-matter or terms make it impossible that it should have effect as modified in the manner provided by this subsection, have effect as from the date of the assignment thereof, as if—
 - (a) the Company had been a party thereto;
 - (b) for any reference to the Board there were substituted, as respects anything falling to be done on or after the commencement of this Act, a reference to the Company; and
 - (c) for any reference to an officer of the Board who is not a party thereto and beneficially interested therein there were substituted, as respects anything to be done on or after the commencement of this Act, a reference to such officer of the Company as the Company shall designate.
- (3) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2), documents, other than those referred to therein, which refer specifically or generally to the Board shall be construed in accordance with the said subsection as far as applicable.

5. Whenever in pursuance of this Act, any property, rights, liabilities or obligations of the Board are deemed transferred in respect of transfer of which any written law provides for registration, the Board shall make an application in writing to the proper officer of the appropriate registration authority for the registration or such transfer, and such officer shall make such entries in the appropriate register as shall give effect to such transfer and, where appropriate, issue to the transferee concerned a certificate of title in respect of the said property or make necessary amendments to the register, as the case may be, and if presented therefor, make endorsement on the deeds relating to the title, right or obligation concerned; and no registration fees, stamp duty or other duties shall be payable in respect thereof.

Registration of property to be transferred by Board

6. (1) Where any person who was in the service of the Board immediately before the commencement of this Act voluntarily transfers from that service to the service of the Company, his terms and conditions of service with the Company shall be no less favourable than those he enjoyed while in the service of the Board, and his previous service with the Board shall be treated as service under the Company for the purposes of determining his rights to, or eligibility for, pension, gratuity, leave or other benefits.

Transfer of service of employees

(2) A person to whom subsection (1) applies shall be deemed to have voluntarily transferred from the service of the Board to the service of the Company unless within three months from the commencement of this Act he gives notice in writing to the Board, with a copy thereof to the Company, stating his intention not to transfer from the service of the Board to the service of the Company.

Legal proceedings

- 7. (1) Without prejudice to the other provisions of this Act, where any right, liability or obligation vests in the Company by virtue of this Act, the Company and all other persons shall, as from the commencement of this Act, have the same rights, powers and remedies (and in particular the same rights as to the instituting or defending of legal proceedings or the making or resisting of applications to any authority) for ascertaining, perfecting or enforcing that right, liability or obligation as they would have had if it had at all times been a right, liability or obligation of the Company.
- (2) Any legal proceedings or application to any authority pending immediately before the commencement of this Act by or against the Board may be continued by or against the Company.
- (3) After the commencement of this Act, proceedings in respect of any right, liability or obligation which was vested in, held, enjoyed, incurred or suffered by the Board may be instituted by or against the Company.

Repeal and savings. Cap. 390

- 8. (1) The Cold Storage Board of Zambia Act shall stand repealed on the appointed date.
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), the provisions of and powers contained in section eleven of the Cold Storage Board of Zambia Act shall continue in force until such date as the Minister may, by statutory instrument, appoint.

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
