# An Act to amend the Civil Service (Local Conditions) Pensions Act

[21st April, 1986

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Civil Service (Local Conditions) Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1986, and shall be read as one with the Civil Service (Local Conditions) Pensions Act, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement. Cap. 410

- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into o peration on the 1st January, 1986.
- 2. Section two of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by the deletion of the definition of "pensionable age" and the substitution therefor of the following definition:

Amendment of section 2

- " pensionable age " means-
  - (a) in the case of a male officer, the fifty-fifth anniversary of the date of his birth; and
  - (b) in the case of a female officer, the fiftieth anni-
- 3. Section five of the principal Act is amended by the repeal of subsection (1) and the substitution therefor of the following subsection:

Amendment of section 5

- (1) The Fund shall periodically be valued by an actuary appointed by the Minister.
- 4. Section seven of the principal Act is repealed and the following sections are substituted therefor:

Rpeal and replacement of sectoin 7

7. There is hereby established the Civil Service (Local Establish-Conditions) Pensions Fund Board which shall be a body ment of Board

corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal, capable of suing and being sued in its corporate name, and with power, subject to the provisions of this Act, to do all such acts and things as a body corporate may do by law.

Composition of Board 7A. The Board shall consist of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Finance, as chairman and six other members appointed by the Minister who shall hold office until the Minister decides otherwise.

Secretary and other staff

- 7B. (1) There shall be a Secretary to the Board who shall be appointed by the Board on such terms and conditions as the Board may determine, with the approval of the Minister.
- (2) The Secretary shall be responsible for the administration of the day-to-day affairs of the Board under the general supervision of the Board.
- (3) The Board may appoint such other staff as it may consider necessary for the performance of its functions.

Functions of Board

- 7C. The functions of the Board shall be-
  - (a) to manage the Fund and in particular to invest moneys belonging to the Fund in a business like manner; and
  - (b) to establish a scheme for home ownership by civil servants and to grant, on such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Board, loans to members of the Fund for the purposes of building or purchasing their own residential properties and meeting any other incidental charges thereto.

Financial vear

7D. The financial year of the Board shall be the period of twelve months ending on 31st December in each year.

Books of

- 7E. (1) The Board shall keep proper books of accounts and other records relating to its accounts.
- (2) Such books of accounts and other records shall be open for inspection by the Minister or any person duly authorised by him in that behalf.

Audit of

- 7F. (1) The accounts of the Board shall be audited annually and a detailed report thereon submitted to the Minister and to the Board.
- (2) For the performance of his duties under subsection (1), the auditor to the Board shall have access at all reasonable times to all books of accounts, records, returns, reports and other documents relating to the Board's accounts.

- (3) In respect of each financial year, the auditor to the Board shall certify whether or not—
  - (a) he has received all the explanations and other information necessary for the performance of his duties;
  - (b) the accounts of the Board have been properly kept; and
  - (c) according to the explanations and other information received, and the books of accounts, records, returns, reports and other documents relating to the Board's accounts produced to him, the accounts of the Board reflect a true and accurate financial position of the Board or of its profit and loss position, for the period covered by his certification.
- 7G. (1) As soon as is practicable, but not later than six Annual months after the expiry of each financial year, the Board report shall submit to the Minister a report containing a balance sheet showing the assets and liabilities of the Board as at the last day of the financial year to which the report relates, accompanied by an audited statement of income and expenditure for that financial year together with any other statements and returns as may be relevant.
- (2) The Minister, may at any time require the Board in writing to submit to him such additional reports, returns or statements, duly certified by the auditor to the Board, as the Minister considers necessary, and the Board shall comply with such requirement.
- (3) The Minister shall, not later than thirty days after the first sitting of the National Assembly next after the receipt of the report referred to in subsection (1) lay it before the National Assembly.
- 5. Section eleven of the principal act is Amended by the repeal of subsection (1) and the substitution therefor of the following subsection:

Amendment of section 11

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this section-
  - (a) an officer in Division I, II or III-
    - (i) shall retire on attaining pensionable age;
    - (ii) may, on giving due notice, retire at any time during the five years before that officer attains pensionable age;
    - (iii) may, on giving due notice, retire at any time after completing twenty-years' service:

(b) an officer of or below the rank of Chief Inspector in the Zambia Police Force or an officer of or below the rank of Chief Officer III in the Zambia Prison Service may, on giving due notice, retire on or after attaining the age of forty-five years or on or after completing twenty years' service which ever is earlier:

Provided that the appropriate authority may, by statutory instrument, prescribe earlier dates for the retirement of all or any officers.

#### Amendment of section 18

- 6. Section eighteen of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by the deletion of:
  - "C= (i) in the case of a female officer whose service commenced prior to 14th September, 1973:660; and
    - (ii) in the case of a male officer who opted to retain fifty-five years as his age of retirement and whose service commenced prior to the 1st December, 1980:660; and
    - (iii) in any other case: 720; and "

### and the substitution therefor of:

"C=the age at which an officer retires, expressed in complete months; and".

#### Amendment of section 19

- 7. Section nineteen of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) by the deletion of:
  - "C= (i) in the case of a female officer whose service commenced prior to 14th September, 1973:660; and
    - (ii) in the case of a male officer who opted to retain fifty-five years as his age of retirement and whose service commenced prior to the 1st December, 1980:660; and
    - (iii) in any other case:720; and "

## and the substitution therefor of:

"C=the age at which an officer retires; expressed in complete months; and".

#### Amendment of section 20

- 8. Section twenty of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of:
  - "C= (i) in the case of a female officer whose service commenced prior to 14th September, 1973:660; and

- (ii) in the case of a male officer who opted to retain fifty-five years as his age of retirement and whose service commenced prior to 1st December, 1980:660; and
- (iii) in any other case:720."

# and the substitution therefor of:

- "O=the age at which an officer retires expressed in complete months.".
- 9. Section twenty-seven of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1) by the deletion of:
  - "D= (i) in the case of a male officer who opted to retain fifty-five years as his age of retirement or in the case of a female officer whose service commenced prior to 1st December, 1980:660; and
    - (ii) in any other case:720; and "

## and the substitution therefor of:

- "D=the age at which an officer retires, expressed in complete months; and".
- 10. Section twenty-eight of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) by the deletion of:

- 11. Section twenty-nine of the principal Act is amended by the deletion in paragraph (b) of:

- "D= (i) in the case of a male officer who opted to retain fifty-five years as his age of retirement or in the case of a female officer whose service commenced prior to 1st December, 1980:660; and
  - (ii) in any other case:720."

## and the substitution therefor of:

"D=the age at which an officer retires, expressed in complete months.".

Amendment of section 55

12. Section fifty-five of the principal Act is amended in subsection (5) by the deletion in paragraph (b) of "whichever is less" and the substitution therefor of "whichever is the greater".

Amendment of action 59

- 13. Section fifty-nine of the principal Act is amended by the repeal of subsection (6) and the substitution therefor of the following:
  - (6) Where an officer is prematurely retired in order to enable him to take up an appointment with a recognised authority the pension of such officer shall be paid with effect from the date of such premature retirement.

Amendment of section 66

- 14. Section sixty-six of the principal Act is amended by—
  - (a) the renumbering of subsection (4) as subsection (5); and
  - (b) the addition, immediately after subsection (3), of the following new subsection:
    - (4) An officer in Division I, II or III who retires may opt to commute either one-third or two-thirds of his pension for a lump sum payment, as gratuity, calculated in accordance with the commutation factors as set out in the Fourth Schedule.

Addition of

15. The principal Act is amended by the addition of the following new section:

Review of penaions

69. There shall be a review of pensions before the 1st October, 1986, and at such intervals thereafter as the Board may decide.

Insertion of Fourth Schedule

16. The principal Act is amended by the addition of the Fourth Schedule as set out in the Appendix hereto.
