

GOVERNMENT OF ZAMBIA

ACT

No. 15 of 1987

Date of Assent: 19th April, 1987

An Act to authorise expenditure from the general revenues of the Republic of the moneys required for the services of the Republic during the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1987, not exceeding in the aggregate, three thousand, nine hundred and fifty-one million, two hundred and nine thousand and three hundred and twenty-four kwacha.

[24th April, 1987

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1987.

2. (1) On the authority of a warrant issued by the President, there may be expended from the general revenues of the Republic such moneys, not exceeding in the aggregate three thousand, nine hundred and fifty-one million, two hundred and nine thousand and three hundred and twenty-four kwacha, as may be required for the services of the Republic during the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1987.

(2) The moneys mentioned in subsection (1) shall be appropriated to the services of the Republic mentioned in the second column of the Schedule in amounts not exceeding the amounts indicated in the third column thereof.

(3) On the written authority of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Finance, the amounts shown under the sub-head of the estimates, may be varied:

Provided that—

- (i) the amounts appropriated to such Head shall not thereby be altered; and
- (ii) any of the amounts shown under Head 20 or 21 shall not be varied.
