An Act to amend the Constitution

[29th July, 1988

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution of Zambia (Amendment) Act, 1988, and shall be read as one with the Constitution.

Short title

2. Article 8 of the Constitution is amended by the repeal of paragraph (b) of clause (1) of that Article.

3. Article 81 of the Constitution is amended by the deletion from clause (2) of that Article of "fourteen days" in both places where it occurs and the substitution for it of "twenty-eight days".

4. Article 123 of the Constitution is amended in clause (1), by the deletion of "within one month of the commencement of each financial year" and the substitution for it of "at least one month before the commencement of each financial year".

5. (1) Notwithstanding the repeal by section 2 of paragraph (b) of clause (1) of Article 8 of the Constitution—

(b) applied

(a) any person who immediately before the commencement of this Act is a citizen of Zambia by reason of registration under that paragraph, shall continue to be a citizen of Zambia;

(b) any person who has commenced residence in Zambia before the commencement of this Act and who, but for the repeal of that paragraph, would have been

entitled to apply for registration as a citizen of Zambia under that paragraph upon the completion of the period of three years' residence prescribed in that paragraph, shall continue to be so entitled as if that paragraph had not been repealed.

(2) Any right to Zambian citizenship preserved under subsection (1) shall be subject to paragraph (b) of Article 9 and Article 11 of the Constitution.
