An Act to amend the employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act

## ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the Employment of Women. Young Persons and Children (Amendment) Act, 1989, and shall be read as one with the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title

The principal Act is amended in Part V, by the insertion immediately before section eighteen, of the following new section-

Insertion of new section

17A. (1) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, but Prohibition subject to subsection (3), a young person shall not be of employment or work which, by of young its nature or the circumstances in which it is carried out, persons in is likely to jeopardise the health, safety or morals of that employment young person.

- (2) The types of employment to which subsection (3) to health, safety and relates shall be prescribed by the Minister by regulations morals made under section twenty after consultation with the relevant trade unions and the employers' associations.
- (3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), the Minister may, in writing, after consultation with the relevant trade unions and employers' associations, authorise the employment of young persons not below the age of sixteen years of age in any type of employment or work prescribed under subsection (2), if satisfied that the health, safety and morals of the young persons are fully protected and that the young persons have received adequate and specific instruction or vocational training in the relevant branch of activity.
