An Act to amend the Central Committee Members', Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Act, 1981.

[18th August, 1989

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Central Committee Members', Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Act, 1989, and shall be read as one with the Central Committee Members', Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1981, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commence-ment Act No. 8

of 1981

- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st July, 1989.
- 2. Section four of the principal Act is repealed and the Repeal and following is substituted therefor:

 of section 4
 - 4. (1) There shall be paid an allowance of K7,584 per Constituency year in lieu of a constituency allowance to—

 and other allowances
 - (a) the Secretary-General of the Party;
 - (b) the Secretary of State for Defence and Security;
 - (c) the Prime Minister; and
 - (d) the Speaker.
 - (2) There shall be paid to an elected member of the National Assembly a constituency allowance as follows:
 - (a) in the case of a member returned by a constituency specified in Part 1 of the Second Schedule, K7,584 per year; and
 - (b) in the case of a member returned by a constituency specified in Part II of the Second Schedule, E3,732.

- (3) There shall be paid to a nominated member of the National Assembly who is not a Member of the Central Committee of the Party, an allowance of K2,652 per year in lieu of a constituency allowance.
- (4) There shall be paid to a member of the Central Committee other than the Secretary-General of the Party, the Secretary of State for Defence and Security and the Prime Minister an allowance of K3,540 per year in lieu of a constituency allowance.
- (5) There shall be paid to a member of the Central Committee of the Party, a Minister and Junior Minister—
 - (a) an electricity allowance of K1,200 per year; and
 - (b) a water allowance of K720 per year.

Amendment of section 5

- 3. Subsection (1) of section five is amended—
 - (a) in paragraph (a) by the deletion of "K19,610" and the substitution therefor of "K25,476"; and
 - (b) in paragraph (b) by the deletion of "K10,530" and the substitution therefor of "K13,650".

Amendment of First Schedule 4. The First Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and the First Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto is substituted therefor.
