## An Act to amend the Citizenship of Zambia Act

[23rd July, 1990

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

1. This Act may be eited as the Citizenship of Zambia (Amendment) Act, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Citizenship of Zambia Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

2. Section *nineteen* of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of subsection (1) and the substitution therefor of the following subsection:

(1) A person to whom the provisions of Article 6 of the Constitution of Zambia apply and who is a citizen or who may have a claim of the citizenship of a country other than Zambia shall not cease to be a citizen of Zambia upon attaining the age of twenty-two years unless he voluntarily renounces his citizenship when he attains the age of twenty-one years.
