ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Sales Tax (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1992, and shall be read as one with the Sales Tax Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on 1st July, 1992.

2. Section six of the principal Act is amended in paragraph (c) of subsection (1) by the deletion of sub-paragraph (ii) and by the substitution therefor of the following sub-paragraph:

(ii) the amount of customs and excise duty, if any, payable on such goods; and

3. The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended by the deletion of sub-item (c) in column 2 of item 1.01 and by the substitution therefor of the following sub-item:

(c) excise duty is payable under the Second Schedule of the Customs and Excise Act, Cap. 662, except for those goods listed on the Fourth Schedule, which shall be liable to tax.

4. The principal Act is smended by the insertion immediately after the Third Schedule of the Fourth Schedule set out in the Appendix to this Act Enectment

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

1. This Act may be cited as the Kenneth Kaunda Foundation (Amendment) Act, 1992, and shall be read as one with the Kenneth Kaunda Foundation Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is amended in the long title by the deletion of "Kenneth Kaunda" and the substitution therefor ot "Zambia Educational Publishing House".

3. The principal Act is amended in the short title by the deletion of "Kenneth Kaunda " and the substitution therefor of "Zambia Educational Publishing House".

4. Section two of the principal Act is amended by the deletion in the definition of "Foundation" of the words "Kenneth Kaunda "and the substitution therefor of "Zambia Educational Publishing House ".

5. Section three of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of the words "Kenneth Kaunda" and the substitution therefor of "Zambia Educational Publishing House".

6. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section four and the substitution therefor of the following section :

4. (1) The Zambia Educational Publishing House shall Composition of be composed of-

- (a) the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education who shall be the Chairman;
- (b) the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Finance who shall be the Vice-Chairman;
- (c) four persons from the private sector appointed by the Minister.
