An Act to amend the Trades Licensing Act

[30th April, 1993

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Trades Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1993, and shall be read as one with the Trades Licensing Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement

Cap. 707

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 30th January, 1993.

2. The Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and the Schedule set out in the Appendix is substituted therefor.

In this Schedule "specified area" means—

- (a) the area for the time being of any city or municipality declared, or deemed to have been declared, to be the area of such city or municipality under the Local Government Act No. 22 of 1991;
- (b) the area for the time being declared as Lusaka Rural District Council under the Local Government Act No. 22 of 1991.
