1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1993, and shall be read as one with the Liquor Licensing Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 30th January, 1993.

2. The principle Act is amended by the repeal of the Schedule R_{o} and the substitution therefor of the Schedule set out in the Appendix to this Act.
