An Act to amend the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1992.

131st December, 1994

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Act, 1994, and shall be read as one with the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) Act, 1992, hereinaster referred to as the principal Act.
 - (2) This Act shall come into operation on 1st January, 1995.
- 2. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section two and the substitution therefor of the following:
 - 2. (1) Subject to this section there shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the First Schedule-
 - (a) a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the second column of the First Schedule:
 - (b) a special allowance at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the third column of the First Schedule; and
 - (c) allowances in respect of postal and secretarial expenses incurred by the holder of the office of private member at the annual rate prescribed in the fourth and fifth columns of the First Schedule.

Repeal and replacement of section 2

Salaries and allowances

Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment)

(2) There shall be paid to the leader of the opposition a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the First Schedule.

Insertion of section 2A

3. The principal Act is amended by the insertion immediately after section *two* of the following new section:

Constituency allowance

- **2A.** (1) There shall be paid to a member of the National Assembly a constituency allowance calculated—
 - (a) in the case of a member returned by a constituency specified in Part I of the Third Schedule, at the annual rate specified in the second column of the Second Schedule; and
 - (b) in the case of a member returned by a constituency specified in Part II of the Third Schedule, at the annual rate specified in the third column of the Second Schedule.
- (2) There shall be paid to a nominated member of the National Assembly in lieu of a constituency allowance, an allowance calculated at the annual rate of nine hundred and ninety-five thousand two hundred and twelve kwacha.

Amendment of section 4

- 4. Section four of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) in subsection (1) by the deletion of the words "twenty-five per centum of his salary." and the substitution therefor of the words "thirty-five per centum of the total of his salary and all allowances. ";
 - (b) in subsection (2) by the deletion of the words "three years " and the substitution therefor of the words " five years or part thereof ";
 - (c) in the proviso to subsection (2) by the defetion of the words "three years" and the substitution therefor of the words "five years or part thereof"; and
 - (d) in subsection (3) by the deletion of the words "three years" and the substitution therefor of the words "five years or part thereof".
