MISCELLANEOUS

Savings and transitional provisions

19. (1) Subject to the other provisions of this Act, a person who immediately before the appointed date, held office as a member of the former Commission, shall hold office as a member of the Commission for a period of three months.

(2) After the period referred to in subsection (1) the Commissioners shall be appointed in accordance with this Act.

(3) Nothing in this Act affects the rights or liabilities of any person employed by the former Commission immediately before the appointed date.

(4) On the appointed date, all property, assets, rights, liabilities and obligations of the former Commission shall vest in the Commission established by this Act.

(5) Any proceedings or cause of action instituted or pending by against the former Commission immediately prior to the appointed date, shall continue as if instituted under this Act.

Transfer of staff

20. (1) The employees of the former Commission shall be deemed to be transferred to the Commission from the commencement of this Act.

(2) The service of the employees referred to in subsection (1) shall be treated as continued service.

(3) The employees of the Commission shall continue to contribute to the Public Service Pension Scheme under the Public Service Pensions Act.

Act No. of 1996 Regulations

21. The Minister may, by statutory instrument, make Regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes of this Act.

Repeal of Act No. 5 of 1974

22. The Law Development Commission and Institute of Legislative Drafting Act is hereby repealed.

**An Act to amend the Betting Control Act
[1st April, 1996**

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Betting Control (Amendment) Act, 1996, and shall be read as one with the Betting Control Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the 1st of April, 1996.

Amendment
of section 2

2. The principal Act is amended in section *two*—

(a) in the definition of " race meeting " by the insertion immediately after the words " persons to watch " of the words ", within the country or abroad through television or other media ", ; and

(b) by the insertion in the appropriate place of the following new definition:

" totalizator " means a bookmaker who operates a machine for registering bets at race meetings with a view to divide the total amount (less tax) among those who bet on the winners.

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section *fourteen* and the substitution therefor of the following:

of section 14

14. Every bookmaker licensed under this Act shall be required to pay, at the time of the issue of his licence, and at each renewal, such amounts as the Minister may by statutory instrument prescribe.

4. The principal Act is amended in section *twenty-eighty* by the—

(a) insertion of the following new paragraph:

(g) regulating the business of totalization; and

(b) renumbering of paragraph (g) as paragraph (h).
