**An Act to amend the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices
(Emoluments) Act**

[14th November, 1997

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Bill, 1997, and shall be read as one with the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement

Cap. 262

(2) Subject to subsection (3), this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 18th November, 1996.

(3) Notwithstanding subsection (2), the allowances payable under this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1997.

2. Section *two* of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1)—

Amendment of section 2

(a) by the deletion of paragraph (b) and the substitution therefor of the following:

(b) a special allowance and an allowance for postal expenses at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the third and fourth columns of the First Schedule;

(b) by the deletion of paragraph (c) and the substitution

(c) an allowance for secretarial expenses incurred by the holder of the office of private member at the annual rate prescribed in the fifth column of the First Schedule.

Repeal and replacement of First Schedule

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of the First Schedule and the substitution therefor of the First Schedule set out in the Appendix to this Act.
