An Act to amend the Control of Goods Act

[24th April, 1998

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Control of Goods (Amendment) Act, 1998, and shall be read as one with the Control of Goods Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 31st January, 1998.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended by the addition of the following new items—

-18. Goods in transit through Zambia.

-19, Goods temporarily imported into Zambia.

-20. Goods exported from Zambia for repair and return and in respect of which a certificate to that effect has been issued by an officer of Customs and Excise Division.

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of the Second Schedule and the substitution therefor of the Second Schedule set out in the Appendix to this Act.

4. Section three A of the principal Act shall stand repealed as from 1st July, 1998.
