**An Act to amend the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices  
(Emoluments) Act**

[29th December, 2000

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Act, 2000, and shall be read as one with the Ministerial and Parliamentary Offices (Emoluments) Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title

Cap. 262

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1999.

2. Section two of the principal Act is amended in subsection (1)—

(a) by the deletion of the full stop at the end of paragraph (c) and the substitution therefor of a semi-colon;

(b) by the insertion after paragraph (c) of the following new paragraphs:

(d) a fuel allowance, motor vehicle allowance and an allowance for medical expenses at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the fourth, fifth and sixth columns of the First Schedule; and

(e) a telephone allowance, entertainment allowance and a driver's allowance at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the seventh, eighth and ninth columns of the First Schedule.

3. Section *two A* of the principal Act is amended by the deletion of subsection (1) and the substitution therefor of the following subsection:

(1) There shall be paid to a Member of the National Assembly a constituency allowance calculated at the annual rate specified in the Second Schedule.
