An Act to amend the Local Government Elections Act

[8th September, 2004

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Act.

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Elections Short title and (Amendment) Act, 2004, and shall be read as one with the Local commence-Government Elections Act, in this Act referred to as the principal ment Cap. 282 (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st December, 2001. 2. Section *ten* of the principal Act is amended in subsection Amendment of section 10 (1) by the deletion of the words " be held in 1992 and in every third year thereafter" and the substitution therefor of the words " with effect from 2001 to be held every five years ". 3. Section thirteen of the pricipal Act is amended -Amendment of section 13 (a) by the deletion of the full stop at the end of that section and the substitution therefor of a colon; and

(b) by the insertion after the colon of the following prioviso:


Provided that every councillor of a council elected in the ordinary election held in 2001 shall be deemed to have been elected to hold office for a period of five years commencing on the date of such election and shall continue in office up to the date of the announcement of the next ordinary election.
