## The Customs and Excise (Rebates, Refunds and Remissions) (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1982

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section eighty-nine of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Rebates, Refunds and Remissions) (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1982, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Rebates, Refunds and Remissions) (General) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

Title and commencement

- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 30th January, 1982.
- 2. Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is amended by the deletion in sub-regulation (2) of "shall not exceed K2,000" and the substitution therefor of "shall not exceed K5,000".

Amendment of regulation

3. Regulation 15 of the principal Regulations is amended in sub-regulation (2)— :

Amendment of regulation

- (a) by the deletion of "five kwacha" and the substitution therefor of "ten kwacha"; and
- (b) by the deletion in the proviso of "ten ngwee" and the substitution therefor of "fifty ngwee".
- 4. Regulation 32 of the principal Regulations is amended—

Amendment of regulation 32

- (a) by the deletion in sub-paragraph (a) of "nine ngwee" and "two kwacha" and the substitution therefor of "fifty ngwee" and "ten kwacha" respectively; and
- (b) by the deletion in sub-paragraph (c) of "ten kwacha" and the substitution therefor of "twenty kwacha".
