The Control of Goods Act (Laws, Volume XIII, Cap. 690)

The Control of Goods (Price Control) (Soft Drinks Prices) Regulations, 1982

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section three B of the Control of Goods Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Price Control) (Soft Drinks Prices) Regulations, 1982, and shall be read as one with the Control of Goods (Price Control) (Soft Drinks Prices) Order, 1979, hereinafter referred to as the principal Order.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 30th January, 1982.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is amended in Part II by the deletion of item 1 and the substitution therefor of the following item:
