## The Customs and Excise (Industrial Drawbacks and Rebates) (Amendment) Regulations, 1984

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section eighty-nine of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Industrial Drawbacks and Rebates) (Amendment) Regulations, 1984, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Industrial Drawbacks and Rebates) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the 28th January, 1984.
- 2. The Third Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by the deletion of the part relating to Radio, Electrical Sound Reproducers and Electronic Appliances Manufacturing Industry and the substitution therefor of the following part:

Amendment of Third Schedule

RADIO AND TELEVISION, ELECTRICAL SOUND REPRODUCERS AND ELECTRONIC APPLIANCES MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY

Component parts and materials imported in a completely knocked down condition for use in the manufacture of radios and televisions, electrical sound reproducers and electronic appliances falling within heading 85.15.
