# The Professional Boxing and Wrestling Control Act (Laws, Volume XI, Cap. 542)

## The Professional Boxing and Wrestling Control (Insurance) Regulations, 1984

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section ten of the Professional Boxing and Wrestling Control Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Professional Title Boxing and Wrestling Control (Insurance) Regulations, 1984.

2. No person shall be registered, re-registered or continue to be registered as a boxer, wrestler, official, manager or promoter unless, in addition to complying with other prescribed requirements, he produces to the Board a personal accident insurance policy in the form set out in the Schedule together with the endorsements therein appearing or any other personal accident insurance policy more favourable to the insured in its terms.

## SCHEDULE

### (Regulation 2)

### (Insert Individual Personal Accident Policy here)

#### ENDORSEMENTS

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this policy to the contrary, the cover given by this Policy shall—

- (a) apply to the Insured during training and during tournaments lawfully staged under the laws of the country where such tournaments are staged and shall extend to death or injury occurring during travel by road, air, rail or sea to and from the places where the tournaments are being held or where the training takes place;
- (b) not extend to temporary disablement whether total or partial;
- (c) not extend to medical expenses.
