The Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) Act (Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 601)

The Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 1984

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twenty-seven* of the Loans and Guarantees (Authorisation) Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Loans and Guarantees Title (Authorisation) (Delegation of Functions) Order, 1984.

2. The functions of the Minister under the Act, in so far as such functions relate to the negotiation and signing of the proposed loan agreement between the International Development Association (as Lender) and the Republic of Zambia (as Borrower) for a loan of twenty-one million five hundred thousand Special Drawing Rights (SDR21,500,000) which is about twenty-two million seven hundred and thirty-two thousand one hundred and sixty-five kwacha (K22,732,165) are hereby delegated to Putteho Muketoi Ngonda who is a public officer in the service of the Government of the Republic of Zambia and who is at present serving as Ambassador in the Embassy of the Republic of Zambia at Washington, DC in the United States of America, or, if the said Putteho Muketoi Ngonda is for any reason unable to carry out any of such functions, then the same may be carried out by Silvester Raymond Kabati who is the Charge d'Affaires in the said Embassy.
