**The Education (Primary and Secondary Schools)
(Amendment) Regulations, 1985**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *twelve* of the Education Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

| <p>1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Primary and Secondary Schools) (Amendment) Regulations, 1985, and shall be read as one with the Education (Primary and Secondary Schools) Regulations, 1973, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.</p> | <p>Title</p> |
| <p>2. Regulation 5 of the principal Regulations is amended in sub-regulation (3) by the deletion of the words "the Schedule" and the substitution thereof of "the First Schedule".</p> | <p>Amendment

| <p>3. The principal Regulations are amended by the deletion of regulation 15 and the substitution thereof of the following:</p> | <p>Replacement

| <p>15. (1) Subject to sub-regulation (5), the fees set out in the Second Schedule shall be payable in respect of the matters therein prescribed.</p> | |
| <p>(2) The fees shall be payable in advance on or before the first day of the school term to which they relate; or, in the case of a pupil joining the school after the first day of term, on or before the first day on which such pupil attends the school.</p> | |
| <p>(3) Where a pupil withdraws from the school before the completion of a term, a refund of fees paid shall be made in accordance with sub-regulation (4):</p> | |

Provided that no fees shall be refunded if the pupil is expelled from school on grounds of discipline or if his withdrawal from school is connected with discipline.

(4) For the purpose of calculating a refund of fees, the total number of days in the term shall be divided into four equal parts and the refund shall be *pro rated* according to the number of quarters of the term, or part thereof, that the pupil was in attendance at the school.

(5) The fees set out in the Second Schedule shall not be payable by any pupil who is a Zambian, or if either of his or her parents—

(a) is a Zambian; or

(b) is an employee of the Government of the Republic of Zambia.

4. The principal Regulations are amended by re-numbering the existing Schedule as First Schedule and by inserting, immediately after that Schedule, of the Second Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto.
