The Aviation (Insurance for Private Aircraft) Regulations, 1985

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section four of the Aviation Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Aviation (Insurance for Private Aircraft) Regulations, 1985.

2. Unless the context otherwise requires, words and phrases in these Regulations shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Air Navigation Regulations.

3. No private aircraft shall be allowed to fly within the Zambian flight information region unless it is insured—

Insurance for private aircraft

- (a) for at least K100,000 in respect of loss to third parties;
- (b) for at least K50,000 for each passenger seat in respect of loss arising from damage to the aircraft or injury to passengers.
