**The Fisheries (Registration of Fishing Boats)
Order, 1986**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *ten* and *twenty-one* of the Fisheries Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Fisheries (Registration of Fishing Boats) Order, 1986. Title

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires—
“fishing boat” means any water craft whether mechanically powered or not, used for or in connection with commercial fishing.

3. (1) Every fishing boat shall be registered with the Director. Registration
of fishing
boats

(2) A fishing boat registered under paragraph (1) shall be allocated a number which shall be displayed on both sides of the hull.

(3) Any person who fails to register a fishing boat or to comply with sub-regulation (2) shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred kwacha or to imprisonment not exceeding three months, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
