The Customs and Excise Act (Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 662)

The Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Neon and General Signs Limited) Regulations, 1986

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, as read with regulation 22 of the Customs and Excise (Rebates, Refunds and Remissions) (General) Regulations, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Neon and General Signs Limited) Regulations, 1986.

2. (1) The Controller shall remit the whole of the duty payable on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto when imported by Neon and General Signs Limited.

(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under subregulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them free from duty, except with the consent of the Controller and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate leviable at the date of each sale or disposal.
