The Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Mumbwa Cotton Ginnery Limited) Order, 1986

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section eighty-nine of the Customs and Excise Act, as read with regulation (22) (2) of the Customs and Excise (Rebates, Refunds and Remissions) (General) Regulations, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Mumbwa Cotton Ginnery Limited) Order, 1986.

2. (1) The Controller shall remit the whole of the duty payable on the goods imported by Mumbwa Cotton Ginnery Limited set out in the Schedule hereto.

(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under paragraph (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them free of duty, except with the consent of the Controller and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal.
