The Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Farmers Wood Manufacturers and Transporters Limited) Regulations, 1987

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section eighty-nine of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Farmers Wood Manufacturers and Transporters Limited) Regulations, 1987.

Title

2. (1) The Controller shall remit the whole duty payable on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto when imported by Farmers Wood Manufacturers and Transporters Limited up to a value of approximately four hundred thousand, two hundred and five kwacha.

Remission of duty

(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under sub-regulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them free of duty, except with the consent of the Controller and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal.
