The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties) Regulations, 1987

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and The Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties) Regulations, 1987.

2. The duties appearing in the excise tariff set out in the Second Schedule of the Act, in so far as they apply to the goods appearing in the Schedule hereto, are suspended to an extent sufficient to reduce such duties to the effective rates shown in the Schedule.

3. The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Excise Duties) Regulations, 1968, are hereby repealed.
