**The Customs and Excise Act**  
(Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 662)**The Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Zambia  
Electricity Supply Corporation Limited)  
Regulations, 1987**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Zambia Electricity Supply Corporation Limited) Regulations, 1987. Title

(1) The Controller shall remit the whole duty payable on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto when imported by Zambia Electricity Supply Corporation Limited up to a value of approximately thirty-seven million, eight hundred and fifty-eight thousand, six hundred and seventy-five French francs. Remission  
of duty

(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under sub-regulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them free of duty, except with the consent of the Controller and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal.
