2. The allowances payable to councillors shall be as set out in Schedule hereto.

Explanatory Notes

(i) The sitting allowance specified in paragraph (a) shall be payable only if the councillor concorned attends a full session of the council, or, being a member of a committee or sub-committee of the council, attends a full seesion of such committee or sub-committee.

(ii) Daily subsistence allowance is payable where a conncillor has stayed. on council business, for one or more nights in any place other than his usual place of abode.

(iii) Daily subsistence allowance is not payable to a councillor who, being the Chairman of a Ward, has stayed for one or more nights in any place within the Ward of which ho is Chairman.

(iv) Where a councillor is provided with transport by the council concerned for the purpose of enabling him to attend a meeting of the council, or a com-mittee or sub-committee of the council, the amount of sitting allowance payable to such councillor shall be one-half of the amount specified in this Schedule.

(v) Where any travel outside Zambia is sponsored, the daily subsistence Allowance payable to a councillor who is entitled to it shall be K80.

(vi) For the purpose of this Order, "session" means the whole period of sitting or sittings to cover the entire agenda.
