The Customs and Excise Act
(Laws, Volume XII, Cap. 662)

The Customs and Excise (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1988

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1988, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (General) Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 63 of the principal Regulations is amended by the deletion of sub-regulation (1) and the substitution therefor of the following sub-regulation:

(1) Any person wishing to manufacture goods liable to excise duty or surtax or any potable liquid, other than honey beer, containing more than two per cent of alcohol by volume, shall make application to the Controller in writing for a licence in terms of section *ninety-three* of the Act.

3. Regulation 80 of the principal Regulations is amended in sub-regulations (a) and (b) by the deletion of "Sykes hydrometer" and the substitution therefor of the words "Gay Lussac's hydrometer".
