The Chiefs (Recognition) Order, 1988

WHEREAS the President is satisfied that the person named in the Schedule hereto is entitled to hold the office specified therein as required by subsection (2) of section three of the Chiefs Act:

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers contained in section three of the Chiefs Act, the following Order is hereby made:

1. This Order may be cited as the Chiefs (Recognition) Order, 1988. Title
