| 4. In retail bottle stores in any brewing area, Mosti or Muchinga | K3.75 per 375 ml bottle |
| 5. In any public bar or restaurant in any brewing area, Mosti or Muchinga | K4.00 per 375 ml bottle |
| 6. In ungraded and 1 star hotels in any brewing area, Mosti or Muchinga | K4.50 per 375 ml bottle |
| 7. In 2 and 3 star hotels, national parks and lodges in any brewing area, Mosti or Muchinga | K5.50 per 375 ml bottle |
| 8. In any 4 star hotel in any brewing area, Mosti or Muchinga | K6.50 per 375 ml bottle |
| 9. In any 5 star hotel in any brewing area, Mosti or Muchinga | K7.00 per 375 ml bottle |
