IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *eighty-nine* of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Remissions) (Small Industries Development Organisation) Regulations, 1989. Title

2. (1) The Controller shall remit the whole duty payable on the goods set out in the Schedule to these Regulations when imported by Small Industries Development Organisation up to a value of approximately one hundred and seventy thousand four hundred and thirty-two United States dollars. Remission  
of duty

(2) The goods on which duty has been remitted under sub-regulation (1) shall not be sold or otherwise disposed of to any person not entitled to import them free of duty, except with the consent of the Controller and upon payment of duty, if any, at the rate leviable at the date of such sale or disposal.
