The Births and Deaths Registration (General) (Amendment) Rules, 1990

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section twenty-one of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, the following Rules are hereby made:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (General) (Amendment) Rules, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Births and Deaths Registration (General) Rules, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules.

2. The principal Rules are amended by the revocation of the Second Schedule and the substitution therefor of the Second Schedule set out in the Appendix hereto.
