The Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section eighty-nine of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Suspension) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990, and shall be read as one with the Customs and Excise (Suspension) Regulations, 1987, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.
